

Where to find us

From Morpeth – Take the Mitford Road at the north end of Morpeth (Bullers Green) and continue for about 2 miles on the B6343.

Alternatively

From the North – Leave the A1 at A192 slip road to Morpeth. Turn right under A1 bridge marked Alnwick. Turn immediately towards Pigdon. Turn left after 400 yards signpost to Mitford. Continue for about 1 mile and turn right at T junction (next to river).

Either way this gets you to Mitford, continue through the village travelling west. As you climb out of the village take the first left. Continue down the hill over the narrow bridge. As you cross the river Wansbeck you will see the church on the right hand side of the lane – opposite the castle ruins.

From the South - Leave the A1 at A197 slip road to Morpeth. Turn immediately left towards "Whitehouse Centre". Continue through Glorum to T junction where you turn right. Turn left after 200yds and continue through Tranwell Woods. Turn right at next T junction. Continue over staggered cross-roads (B6524) to Mitford. Follow road 1 mile to final T junction where you turn right bringing you down past the Church.

Location

Nestled below the ruins of the castle and adjacent to a church that has witnessed to Christ for centuries, the Parish Centre is to be found in the beautiful Northumbrian countryside on the outskirts of Mitford. Mitford is a small village 2 miles west of Morpeth.

It is central to all locations within the county and offers easy access from Tyneside.

The Parish Centre is situated between the church and the vicarage.

Accommodation



The building provides access and toilet facilities for the disabled.

There is a small but well equipped kitchen and crockery, cutlery and ancillary kitchen equipment can also be made available.

There is even a supply of toys that are used by the crèche.

There is one main room that measures approx. 13.5 metres long by 4.3 metres wide. This can be subdivided into three equal sized areas by the use of sliding screens. This allows for flexibility in the permutations of layout that can be used to meet most requirements.

There is a very efficient oil fired heating system that operates a series of radiators.

There are a number of chairs (comfortable) and tables provided.

The room can accommodate approx. 70 people standing and approx 50 people seated.

Other Information

The Church can be made available to a group for worship or quiet prayer time. This is of course subject to the activities within the Parish.

It is possible to provide a list of caterers who would be willing to provide refreshments for you should this be required.

There are walks around the area and maps can be provided.

We will also arrange that someone will be there to greet you with a welcome cup of

coffee and to ensure that your stay is trouble free.

You are welcome to organise a visit to see if the Parish Centre will meet your requirements.
